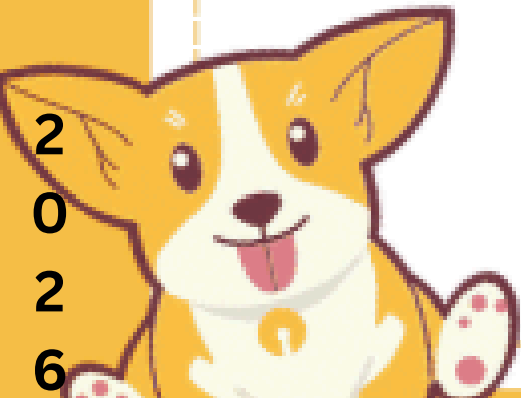

- ◆ Explorer House: The Puzzle of Life — “Every piece matters.”

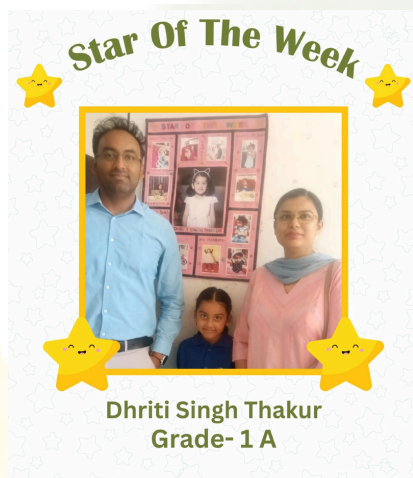
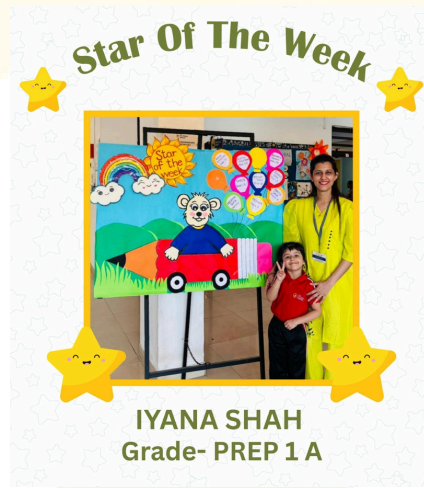
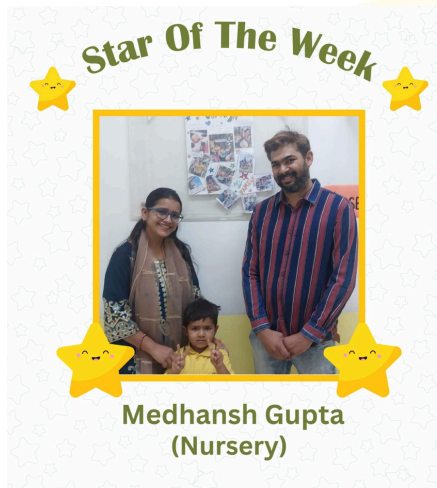


From futuristic visions to meaningful life lessons, the boards reflected not only artistic excellence but also powerful messages that resonate with today’s world.
